# Bicycle Infrastructure Best Practices

### **Shared Use Facilities**

The following shared facility types can make walking or biking safer and easier.

#### **Shared Use Paths**


Shared use paths, also known as pathways or trails, are multi-use, twoway facilities that are completely separated from motor vehicle traffic. They can run through parks and along streams and rivers, railroad corridors, or other off-street corridors.

#### In Roadway Shared Use Paths

In roadway shared use paths are similar to shared use paths, but they run within the roadway right-of-way when appropriate and feasible. These projects can be temporary or permanent and represent an opportunity for lower-cost solutions along roadways with excessive widths.

#### Intersection Treatments

The following treatments can make biking and using micromobility modes like scooters safer and easier.

## **Bike Boxes**

A bike box is a designated area at the head of a traffic lane at a signalized intersection that provides bicyclists with a safe place and visible way to get ahead of queuing traffic during the red signal phase.

#### **Traffic Calming**

Traffic calming measures like painted curb or landscape extensions reduce intersection crossing distances, provide a safe place for bicyclists to pause, tighten curve radii, increase visibility for all road users, and slow traffic speeds.

#### **Bicycle Signals**

Bicycle signals can be used at standard signalized intersections and hybrid signal crossings. They help cyclists by clarifying when to enter an intersection and by restricting conflicting turn movements.
