#### Plan Purpose

The purpose of this plan is to identify opportunities and constraints for bicycling in the Huntsville MPO region, and to establish recommendations for improvement. This plan includes recommendations for easy, quick-win projects that create immediate impact, as well as long-term, visionary projects that may require additional funding, design, and coordination. The plan provides a phased set of implementation strategies to accomplish the stated project vision and goals, as described below.

#### **Project Vision**

As a **connected**, **safe**, and **comfortable** place for bicycling for all ages and abilities, the **Greater Huntsville MPO region is a premier location for bicycle transportation and recreation.** A **culture** emerges where bicycling is **accessible** and **fun**, helping attract and retain workforce and contributing to a strong regional economy.

#### **Project Goals**



Provide **connectivity** between destinations, existing greenways, and across municipalities.



Increase **equitable** bicycle transportation and utilitarian options for underserved areas, including improved access to transit, schools, and major employers.



Prioritize **safety** in bikeway development and programs, building off Vision Zero efforts.



Build a bicycling **culture** where all roadway users are more considerate, through education, encouragement, and safety programs.



Build high-quality, **comfortable** bike facilities that improve experience and increase ridership.







# Demand Analysis Active Trip Potential


### PERCENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE TRIPS UNDER 3 MILES

In MPO Area (2016-2022)




# Total Crashes with Bikes

Improving safety for bicyclists is a main priority for the bicycle plan. Identifying where bicycle crashes have occurred and understanding the conditions and contributing factors is the first step to making our roads safer to bike. The project team gathered crash data from 2016 to 2022 to identify crash locations and density. As seen on this map, some of the most severe crashes are happening on busy roads and at intersections.
